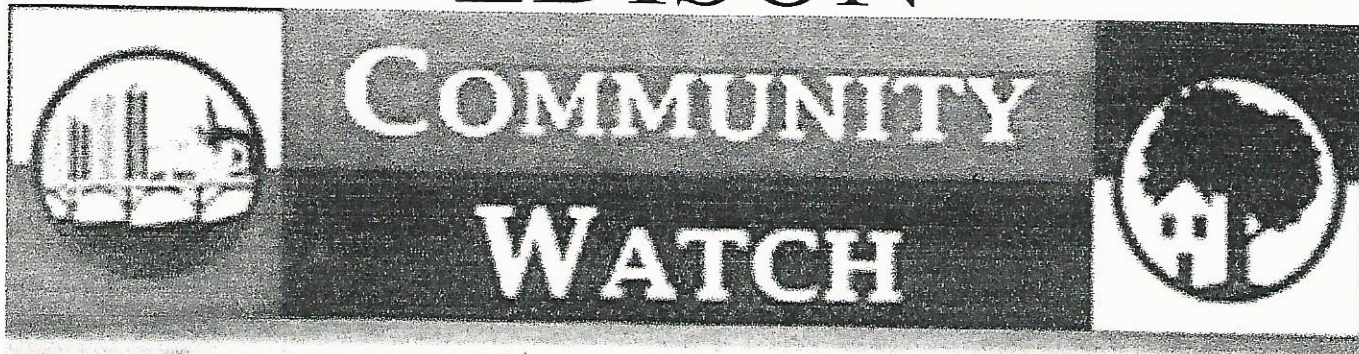

## **CELL PHONE THEFT PREVENTION TIPS**
