

KEEPING SIDEWALKS CLEAR

Hammond City Ordinance 101.007 "The occupant or owner, if there is not occupant, of each and every tenement building or lot in the city fronting upon any improved sidewalk shall clear the sidewalk in front of the tenement building or lot of snow or ice by 10:00am of each day and keep the sidewalk clear of snow or ice."
(This applies to businesses, apartment buildings and single family homes)

LEND A HAND

If a senior or handicapped resident lives in your neighborhood, help them clear their sidewalk. It's a great way to get to know your neighbors and warm the heart of someone in need.

BE PREPARED FOR A WINTER STORM

Listen to our local radio or TV stations for regular updates

Dress for cold weather

- Wear several layers of loose fitting, lightweight clothing
- Wear mittens instead of gloves
- Wear a hat
- Wear boots and take small steps to avoid slipping on ice

Winterize your vehicle

- Avoid auto gas line freeze ups by keeping your tank greater than half full at all times
- Make sure your car has adequate antifreeze
- Make sure your tires have good traction and are inflated to the right pressure
- Make sure your heater and defroster work properly
- Make sure you have a good ice scraper

Park your car off the street to allow snow plows to clear your street
